 - b. Transplanting plugs to gallon size pots
 - c. Set-up and assist with transplanting volunteer events
 - d. Maintaining nursery equipment and systems
2. Participate in “Get Rooted” transplanting event on April 5th
3. Document time, travel (if any), and project activities/accomplishments

- Learn about life at a nonprofit organization.

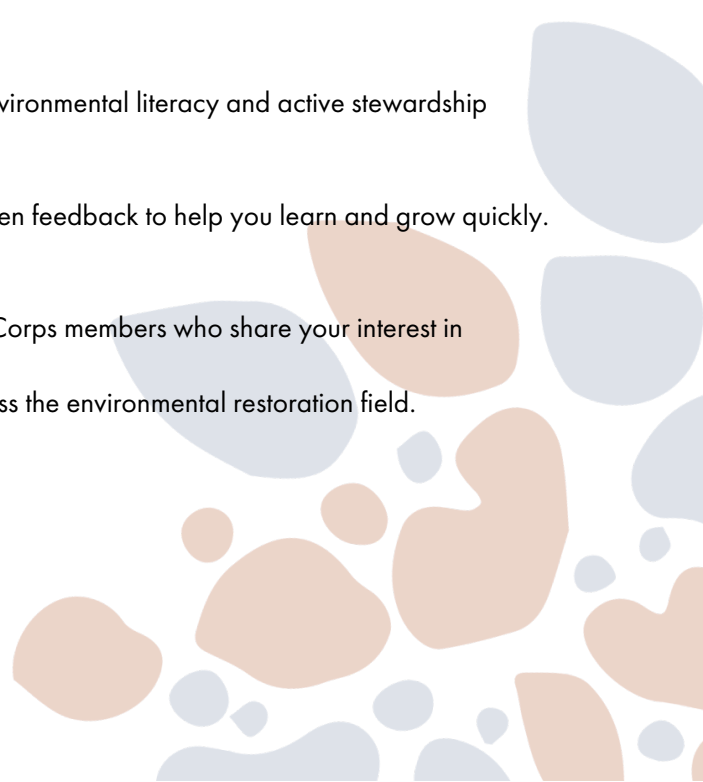
